The Dr. E.P. Scarlett music program has invited our feeder schools to this event, and this year, musicians from David Thompson, Fairview, Robert Warren, Harold Panabaker and Woodman will be joining us for this fast-paced concert. Students, families, and guests alike will witness the fine music making that takes place every day in the band rooms of our great schools.

The concert is open to all, so invite your friends, family and co-workers along for this evening extravaganza. The tickets are on sale for the **low price of \$17** (plus theatre fees and taxes), which helps to offset the cost of renting this incredible venue.

The concert is on **Tuesday March 11 2025** at the Jack Singer Concert Hall. Doors open at 6:10 pm with a downbeat of **6:30 pm**.

STUDENTS:

Days leading up to the concert: After each performance, please take the uniform parts out of their bag and hang them up. This will allow the uniforms to dry out and reduce unpleasant odors. If the uniform is getting a little ripe, it's time for a cleaning. Uniform parts are DRYCLEAN ONLY.

Morning of the concert: Remember to bring your complete uniforms, instruments, and music to school. Hang your uniform on the racks outside the band room. We will be loading the equipment truck at 10:00 am for all percussion and large wind instruments. The truck will be open at 12:00 pm lunch as well for tubas and bari saxes.

5:45 pm	Gr. 10 band change into uniform.
6:00 pm	Wind Ensemble in warm-up. Symphonic and Choir change into uniform
6:10 pm	Doors Open
6:25 pm	All Scarlett musicians seated together in the highest balcony

6:30 pm	Concert Begins
7:15 pm	Intermission
8:30 pm	Approximate concert finish time. Students assist with the loading of the truck. Students go home with their parents. No buses provided.

REMINDERS FOR STUDENTS:

During the concert, at times, you may be seated in the balcony to watch the concert. This is a huge benefit to you as students as you will be able to take in the performances (and not be waiting in a storage room all night). You will also be able to support your fellow musicians. Doing so will require conduct that is focused, appropriate and respectful. No cell phones. No talking – conversation only happens after applause. You are required to stay in very specific locations. Follow all directions given. **Proper performance and audience member etiquette:** You are expected to stay for the entire concert, to support all performances, and to assist with the tear down at the end.

PARENTS:

The doors will open at 6:10 pm with the concert scheduled to begin at 6:30pm. At the conclusion of the evening (approx.. 8:45 pm after we load the truck), please take your student home with you, **as there is no transportation provided back to the school.**

PARKING:

This is underground parking in the Arts Common building. Access is on MacLeod Trail, just after 9th avenue, on the left side of the street. There is also a parking lot on the south side of 9th avenue, after 1st street SE and before Macleod Trail.
